FEMALE RESPONSES

Partner Violence

21 female respondents reported experiencing partner violence since starting school at LCC.

Of these females:

3 reported it happening on campus	4 said it happened one time
6 told no one	6 said it happened 2 - 4 times
0 reported it to police	4 said it happened 5 or more times
0 reported it to campus security	7

MALE RESPONSES

Partner Violence

14 Male respondents reported experiencing partner violence since starting school at LCC.

Of these Males:

1 reported it happening on campus	5 said it happened one time
7 told no one	1 said it happened 2 - 4 times
1 reported it to police	1 said it happened 5 or more times
0 reported it to campus security	6 were not sure how many times
0 reported it to LCC staff/faculty	

Survey Definition: Partner violence is when your boy/girlfriend, husband/wife, date, lover and/or special friend are abusive to you. This can include verbal abuse (like name calling or put downs), physical abuse (like hitting, slapping or pushing) and/or emotional/mental abuse (like threatening you or your family, controls who you see/talk to, controls the money, and/or drives carelessly with you in the car).
