98 female responses

60 male responses

MALE RESPONSES

Partner Violence

4 Male respondents reported experiencing partner violence since starting school at UHWO.

Of these Males:

1 reported it happening on campus

0 said it happened one time

1 told no one

2 said it happened 2 - 4 times

0 reported it to police

0 said it happened 5 or more times

0 reported it to campus security

2 were not sure how many times

1 reported it to UHWO staff/faculty

Survey Definition: Partner violence is when your boy/girlfriend, husband/wife, date, lover and/or special friend are abusive to you. This can include verbal abuse (like name calling or put downs), physical abuse (like hitting, slapping or pushing) and/or emotional/mental abuse (like threatening you or your family, controls who you see/talk to, controls the money, and/or drives carelessly with you in the car).
