
Inquiries into the Excavated Bamboo Document Hengxian (恒先): Meaning and Importance

In the excavated Daoist texts there are many ultimate ideas such as Da, the One, and Ta. These are the highlights of philosophy in early China. In the a, a bamboo inscription of the Chu state of the Warring States period as collected in the Shanghai Museum, there is a new idea which has direct bearing on the doctrine of cosmic creation and the political theory of the early Daoists.

a is the only one intact inscription remaing The *He* in the unearthed Chu bamboo inscriptions. It is apparently closely related to the Daoists texts: La, , He a , and H a a

This symposium is open to the public and will consist in a presentation of research on the thought of He with international scholars.
