The University of Hawaii Sea Level Center (UHSLC) represents an important thread in the history of oceanographic research at UH. The origin of the center dates to four decades ago when eminent UH physical oceanographer, Klaus Wyrski, established a network of island tide gauges in the tropical Pacific as part of the North Pacific Experiment (NORPAX).
