“Who is Kanaloa? An oceanographic perspective I”

As part of colonial efforts of conversion, early missionaries in Hawai'i translated the concept *akua* as god, or deity. This seminar will introduce a new framework for understanding Hawaiian *akua* with a specific focus on principle *akua* Kanaloa, commonly thought of as the god of the ocean. Attendees will participate in interpretation and retranslation of the *oli* (chant) *E Kanaloanuiakea* (below) through an oceanographic lens. No experience in Hawaiian language is necessary but attendees should bring either a smart phone or laptop.
